ON NOV. 16, 1989 DURING MISSOURI'S FIREARMS DEER
SEASON.

ON THIS PARTICULAR DAY AS I WAS LOADING
THIS WEAPON I PUSHED THE BOLT FORWARD TO CHAMBER
A ROUND AND THE WEAPON DISCHARGED. I REMEMBER
DOING NOTHING OUT OF THE ORDINARY AND AT NO
TIME DID I TOUCH THE TRIGGER. HAVING OWNED
AND USED THIS WEAPON FOR 2 YRS. THIS IS THE
FIRST PROBLEM THAT I HAVE HAD. NOT ONLY DID
