I am writing to you to make a suggestion on how to improve the safety on the Bolt Action Rifles and it could save Remington Arms Co.

Millions of dollars if someone was to get hurt or killed in an accident ~~because of this~~ because of this.

I am 59 years old, disabled. I have been a Remington man all my life, but, there is one feature on the Bolt Action Rifles that I never liked. I can't understand why Remington hadn't made the change years ago. It's having to push the safety to the fire position before you can open the Bolt to load or unload. (It can be corrected by removing the Bolt Lock on the top of the Safety).

Here is an example of what I mean: Three years ago I purchased a used Remington Model 700-22-250 Cal Rifle. I scoped it, shot it in and hunted groundhogs two evenings and when I returned to pickup I pointed the muzzle to
