

the ground and pushed the safety to the off position & it fired into the ground about 10 ft away. My safe gun handling paid off and there was no damage done, but you can see what I mean by the bolt lock making it dangerous to load/unload. I disassembled it as soon as I got home and found that the trigger adjustment was set too light. I reset it to 3 1/2 lbs and yes I also removed the bolt lock. In my opinion making it a lot safer all the way around. I never have to push it off safe except to fire or when removing the bolt for cleaning.

I like to have a light (about 6 1/2 to 6 3/4 lb) Remington Rifle like the Model 700 but with a 24" Barrel, walnut stock, oil finish, Blue Barrel, but, it seems the only ones like that were the Model 721's and they are impossible to find. I'd like it in .270 Win. Caliber. But now that I'm on a disability pension & so is my wife, I'll probably never get one.
