shells was defective but ~~was~~ has  
damaged the barrel which needs  
replacing. The spring and shell  
feeder plate (I'm not sure of the names  
of the parts) were blown off. The bolt  
now freely comes out completely.

Please perform needed repairs.  
I realize the gun's warranty has  
expired years ago but the gun has had  
less than 5 boxes of shells shot and  
was in perfect condition until the  
accident. I have 4 other Remington  
firearms and will certainly buy more
