On June 29th the above rifle fired when the safety was released. At the time of the incident I was traveling in a pick up truck and shot a hole in the bloor board and thru the exhaust pipe. It was very fortunate I did not hit one of my feet or the drivers.

This rifle was then taken out to the rifle range and checked out. It was reloaded and it fired once more when the safety was taken off and then would not do it again after trying several times. When the shell was ejected and another round put in the chamber it would not fire at all, it acted like the safety was on.

This rule was burchased from Chandler's Sporting Goods in Juneau, Alaska sometime in 1969 or 1970. However, he has since gone cut of business. I don't believe that there has been more than 3 or 4 boxes of shells put thru this rifle as I don't hunt with it, just primarily take it for back up for bear protection. No one has worked on this rifle so it has not been altered in any manner from the time it was purchased.

After this happened I was told that there was a recall on these rifles for this problem, but I did not receive any notification to have it taken care of.

This rifle is unsafe for any type of use until it is fixed. I feel that Remington Arms should do the repairs and bear the cost of same. Also that the charges to repair the pick up should be born by Remington.

I would appreciate hearing from you on this matter.
