As per your request, the estimated savings realized by adopting an aluminum Magazine Bottom would amount to approximately \$310.00 commercial cost per normal year, plus a saving of approximately \$1,500.00 equipment cost through the purchase of a casting die rather than to provide equipment for machining the part from steel.

The eliminating of the swivel screw washer by making the swivel screw and washer integral was considered the practical thing to do and not a savings proposition. As a matter of information the savings was approximately \$10.00 per normal year.
