 SUBJECT: MODEL 720 SAFETY COMPLAINT *KAB 2/31.*

We are shipping to you today a Model 720 Rifle No. 40895, ID-169, in which we have incorporated the necessary changes in the Sear and Cocking Piece to eliminate the complaint of "being able to disengage the notches when the Safety is in the three-quarter On position and then firing the rifle by a movement of the safety towards the Off safe position."

The necessary changes in tools are actively under way and new components are being run which, it is estimated, will take four to six weeks to complete before assembly can again be started and warehouse stock changed over.

We feel that the sample gun represents the best condition which it is possible to obtain without a major redesign in the safety mechanism.
