

3. How they (the respondents) expect to use their rifles

- with hunting, as might be expected, uppermost in their minds, as follows:

Rim Fire Rifles

Center Fire Rifles

4. They want pistol grips on their rifles -

- by almost eleven to one.

The findings - all "rifle" respondents:

Pistol grip	91.29%
Straight grip	8.71%

5. Sportsmen's preferences for fore-end designs vary substantially, with only a slight majority preferring fore-ends "like present rifles"Summary - All Rifle Respondents

Similar to present rifles	58.1%
Modified or semi-beaver tail	35.8%
Full beaver tail	6.1%
