

3. As to uses for their shotguns -

- the responding sportsmen report as follows:

Upland game shooting	45.61%
Duck shooting	30.59
Skeet	11.75
Trap	9.42
Deer hunting	2.63

4. As with rifles, the pistol grip is favored -

- by about 8 to 1.

The findings:

Pistol grip	89.10%
Straight	10.90%

This finding holds true of responding sportsmen of all age groups and shooters' ratings, and in approximately the same ratio.

5. The respondents as a whole are, apparently, only fairly well satisfied with present fore-end designs -

- with "gun nuts" and regular shooters less pleased with these designs than are occasional and infrequent shooters.
