NOTE:

The degree of interest expressed in the 30 M1 Carbine would place this rifle in seventh place in the above list.

2. That the pistol type of grip be continued in post war models.
3. That the design of rifle fore-ends be studied to the end of increasing their acceptance by shooting public.
4. That rifle stocks be brown (walnut color), medium to dark in shade, and dull in finish.
5. That rifle barrels be blue-black in color and dull with a velvet texture in finish.
6. That consideration be given to designing a sliding catch safety on the small of the grip (usual double barrel shotgun safety) for rifles.
7. That rifles selling above \$35.00 retail be checkered on grip and fore-end.
8. That high power center fire rifles be marketed optionally with and without recoil pads and that for models fitted with recoil pads, \$3.00 be included in the price for this feature.
9. That center fire rifles except 300 Magnum and Varminters be made lighter in weight, averaging about as follows:

Large frame calibers	7.8 pounds
Medium frame calibers	7.3 pounds
Varminter small frame rifles	7.5 pounds
