SUBJECT: OPERATIONS COMMITTEE - INFORMATIVE BULLETIN -
(b) MODEL 721-722 MAGAZINE FOLLOWER

It is desired to inform the Operations Committee of an improvement in finish for the Magazine Followers used in the Models 721 and 722 rifles, all calibers.

These are purchased blanked and formed from sheet steel with deburring and hardening being done here at Ilion. It has been found that if these Followers are nickel plated, it is possible to eliminate a great deal of repair work and at the same time, there is a significant improvement in appearance, along with added corrosion resistance.

The Plant reports that because of reductions in repairs, it is possible to accomplish this improvement without additional factory cost. We have described the proposed improvement to G. E. Pinckney who has indicated his agreement, and we have therefore approved this change to become effective as soon as practical and on basis of the Operations Committee being informed as to the accomplishment.
