 Belt Specifications same as present Rem-721 but not re-cartridged.  
Rem-721 20-20 exterior; estimated Rem-721 40-42 inside (Chadwick)

We have completed testing the subject Belts for strength and deformation. Results show that these Belts withstand the maximum strength condition of four bullets in the barrel ahead of a 1.4 gram Super X-100 Lead. These conditions are comparable with the results obtain with the original soft threaded Belts.

A dry cycle test which functioned the Rem-721 17,000 rounds failed to produce any adverse deformation of metal in the extractor slot.

It is recommended that the subject product be considered for production of all M/721-722 Belts.
