Re your notice of March 15 and after rereading our notes and minutes of last meeting, suggest following for your agenda:

SHOTGUNS

MODEL 570 - SPTS.-58

Consideration of economics related to proposal for 20 and 40 ga. guns in these models.

MODEL 570 - MAGAZINE CAP

There should be further review of the proposed tentative design to adapt for powder metal production, as on the SPTS.-58. This could not be covered during last trip of Morgan and Foster.

STOCKMAN-X

Reports of the March 14 meeting with Sales (Morgan and Foster) have been distributed.

CENTER FIRE RIFLES

M/121-722 MATCH RIFLE

This item remains to be disposed of.

MODEL 725

Review status of development. It is expected that the two revised samples will be available to Sales. The proposed draft for R&D project for introduction of this model is still available, having been prepared in January 1956. Except for minor changes to gun specification this would still seem to cover the present proposed scope of work.

Process and tool development costs were estimated in August 1956 and then revised in December 1956. H.P. Larsen prepared a preliminary economic summary for Operations Committee 3-23-56. A revised

detail of economics was prepared by Ilion Methods & Standards on 12-11-56. As far as we know there have been no significant changes to the design which would effect cost to any real extent. However, believe that the revisions as requested for the safety will be more expensive, and perhaps the stock checking should be again reviewed for cost. It is not known as to whether or not the plant will have had an opportunity to do this before the April 2 meeting.
