REMINGTON MODEL 725 - INSTRUCTION FOLDERS

Copy and layout for the Instruction Folder has been completed to a point where we would like to have it reviewed and approved by Sales, together with any corrections or suggestions. I am arranging to bring down the layout (which is attached to hardboard) early this coming week. And in the meantime am forwarding an extra copy of the written matter, which you might arrange to start "passing along".

Please note the following suggestions which I have already made to John Finnegan and will probably be incorporated in the corrected copy to be brought down next week.

BACK COVER - UPPER PORTION

Rather than describe the new stock and sight features as "Common Sight Line", "Single Standard Sight Line", and "Dual Purpose Sight Line", it occurred to me that a better name would be "Convertible Sight Line". This term would seem to be more adequate since it is descriptive of "converting" from either open or telescope sights.

INSIDE COVER (HALF FOLD)

Since the Plant has adopted a new <sup>and</sup> improved method of "oiling" to replace the old "grease" that used to be put into the barrels (the new material is a special wax) --- it would seem to me that we should use a more appropriate instruction with regard to the removing of "heavy oil from the bore ----". I have suggested that Finnegan give this a "rewrite" and perhaps incorporating into it the idea of including check of possibility of any other obstructions such as cleaning rags, etc., as well as oils, greases, etc.. His rewrite should be available in the new copy that will be brought down.

Magazine Loading - Since the M/725 can be loaded into the magazine in two different ways (i.e. through the top in the conventional manner or through the bottom with the hinged cover) I suggested that John incorporate some statement to that effect before describing the method of loading through the bottom.
