We have previously supplied the above organization with a Model 721 barreled action in caliber 30/06 for use in laboratory tests of velocity and pressure of experimental propellants under government contract.

In connection with additional work under this contract they would like quotations on Model 721 barreled actions in both 300 H & H Magnum and 220 Swift calibers. They understand that we do not regularly supply this model in 220 Swift but this particular cartridge offers some characteristics, such as powder capacity, which are very desirable to their program. They feel also that the excellent cartridge head support of the 721 has demonstrated its value for their requirement. If we would be unable to supply a Model 721 in 220 Swift caliber, they want to know if it would be possible to obtain a barreled action in .222 Remington caliber (this would be Model 721; not 722) with a bolt for the 30/06 cartridge case. They would then re-chamber the rifle for 220 Swift - with no guarantees expected of Remington.

Please advise if we would be in a position to supply their requirements, and what if any extra cost beyond regular commercial product would be involved. These barreled actions will be for use in laboratory ballistic test guns under a government contract with a Defense rating of DO A1.
