We are now preparing a considerable number of drawings in connection with the above models for transmittal to P.E. & C. We are all sware that he yet there are many things to be resolved in order to class the Plant in preparing for production. As soon as sufficient information has been received to complete an evaluation and the writing of a project, this will be done.
