## XP-100 TRIGGER HOUSING

One of the sample production parts received from you was assembled into the test action and checked for assembly and function. The following points were noted:

- Countersink on tapped holes too deep on some parts. This should be kept to minimum.
- 2. Part easily assembled to barrel bracket.
- 3. Threads OK (diameter).
- 4. Trigger pivot pin hole alignment good. (No cramping of trigger in housing)
- 5. General appearance good.
- 6. Operation satisfactory in assembled action.
