Sample pistol case submitted to sales for consideration (Kolpin Case) has been approved by sales. In uiry should be continued as to the price on quantities of approximately 3,000 cases. This quantity may produce lower price than quoted in Kolpin letter (\$1.50).

- F. E. Morgan suggested also that inquiry should be made as to Remington lable and additional price. If lower price is quoted consideration also should be given to the better or heavier inner material.
- F. E. Morgan will send up three (3) catalogues in which similar type cases are displayed. Retail prices are listed also. These include Kolpin Bros., Buddy Schoellkopf Products, and Stern Co. Catalogues will be returned.

## M/600 Packaging.

Advise from F. E. Morgan is that sales likes very much the sample corton submitted. This carton was obtained from Mohawk Containers and is of the one piece folding type. This corton has been described in a previous memo to Management. The feature of this corton, it will be recalled, is in the inside supporting filler which are die cut as part of the five panel folder.

Suggestion also made by Mr. Morgan that shipping tests of this type of carton be made. This design of box then be studied for use on the complete line of Remington guns.
