PACKAGING - M/600

Thirty-six sample cartons from Mohawk Containers have been delivered to the loading dock. These sample cartons are of the one piece folding type with supporting fillers as part of the folded carton.

Ten (10) drops, 30 inches high, have been witnessed at the vendor's plant. No gun damage resulted. Drops were made with single shipper overwrap or sleeve taped around carton. Slight damage at muzzle end of carton (inside) occurred during muzzle drops. The counter display push-out separated from lid during drops also. This will be revised to strengthen push-out for production runs.

All sample boxes have been marked for delivery to W.A. Best for trial shipments.

Four "white" corrugated cartons are included in the samples as requested by F.E. Morgan.

Sleeve type single shippers are also available for trial shipments.
