Subject Field test of Model 600

The Model 600 is a very nice handled gun, very light in weight and a very nicely balanced "carry" in all positions.

The Model 600 functioned perfectly with all loads used. The trigger pull was excellent. Recoil was quite noticeable with the .308 Win. cartridges. A very sharp edge was noticed on the left side of the magazine opening in the receiver and it struck my thumb ~~and~~ nail in pushing the 2nd-3rd and 4th cartridges into the magazine. I also received three cuts in my thumb from this sharp edge during the test.

Accuracy was fairly good. The rear sight on this gun was in my opinion, very poor. It is almost impossible to do close sight adjustments. The sight is very flimsy and poorly designed.

The Model 600 is very attractive in appearance.
