The Operations Committee has approved the Sales Department's recommendation to add the caliber 6MM Remington to the Model 600 Carbine. The economic justification of doing this are shown in the attached Table 3 from Minute #2- 1964.

the accuracy capability of this caliber in the Model 600 has not yet been demonstrated. R&D feel they will be able to meet the Model 700 specification (tentative) for this caliber of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches extreme spread for a five shot group at 100 yards. They expect to have accuracy results on the prototype Carbine by early March.

The Sales Department wishes to have this caliber available as soon as possible. In order to release Production to obtain necessary tooling and gauges, the Operations Committee recommends you approve adding the caliber 6MM Remington to the Model 600 Carbine. You may indicate your approval by authorizing the attached New Product Approval.
