M-700 BOLT HANDLE

The Bolt Handle made from a screw machine blank and cold worked was discussed with the representative from HAP Die and Stamping Company, with personnel from HAD present (R. P. Kelly and M. H. Walker).

It is realized that the checkering or knurling on the knob, as shown on the model drawing D-26330, does not lend itself to the cold-forming process. However, it was requested by ReD that the vendor review the possibility of omitting the knurl and forming the knob with a distinct band similar to our present handle. If the vendor can produce a handle of this design, he will furnish ReD with a sample which will be assembled to a prototype Bolt for Seles approval.

No work on permanent tooling will be started until approval by Sales has been confirmed and model drawings have been transmitted.
