Nike Walker just passed your mean senserming your problem with the Model 600 over to me. I'll try to help you out as best I can.

As long as you have a Redfield receiver sight and it is satisfactory for your rifls, it will take sare of the front sight by providing one approximately an 1/8 of an inch lever in dimensions. For old fegies like you (and don't forget you were the one who said that), the best way to equip the Model 600 with adequate sighting equipment other than existing sights presented would be to use the long eye relief scope that is being provided for this rifls by the Redfield Gun Sight Company or the new Laupold which has been recently developed for long eye relief use. These two companies are in the process of developing mounts which will fasten on to the front V-ring and barrel bracket and one of the study on the rib and I would say that in the next three to six months this equipment will be available for the forward mounting purposes. Then you can adjust the eye pleas to fit your own eye and have available all the ejection port for it for feeding and ejection of shalls without interference with the seeps mount or scope.

I hope this combination and the one you have, plus the sight that I am sending, will be sufficient for your purposes.
