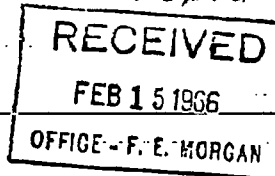

Tried this rifle on two different occasions.
First time temp. was approx 0° and a
30 to 40 mph wind blowing.

Tried at 50 yd target snowing so hard
Could not see 100 yd target.

Rifle functioned perfectly.

Recoil reasonable.

Feeding, extraction & ejection all good.

Trigger pull crisp and good.

As for the accuracy - I can't say much
even though shooting from a bench rest.

The conditions were extremely rough attached
are two targets.

Second time temp approx 40° snow too deep
to get to target so fired rifle for
functioning which was perfect.
