Would you please give me your opinion concerning the installation of a 40XB standard trigger (not the 20Z trigger) in a Rem 700 BDH. 22-250 CAL.

With the current factory trigger in my 700, I am unable to adjust it to a one pound pull (approx) I wrote to Remington Arms about installing a 40XB trigger in the 700. Their answer (enclosed) seems to indicate that they would not recommend it. Still, they sent me a parts brochure for the 40XB (?)

A gunsmith told me that the 40XB trigger would not fit in the 700 action. And that any trigger (on the 700), adjusted to a one pound pull would create a damp of the gun discharging when the bolt is closed. Yet, another gunsmith told me there would be no problem at all.

Since I only hunt woodchucks, most of my shooting is calibrate, in the prone position and with very little moving shooting. So, I don't think the light pull would be dangerous, but I would not want the possibility of the gun going off when I close the bolt. Incidentally, I am not interested in a set trigger.
