SUBJECT: MUZZLE BRAKE, MODEL 600 RIFLE

A while back a special muzzle brake was devised by your Department to be permanently affixed on the Model 600 with the idea to increase its length from 18½" to 19½". This modification was devised to allow the Model 600 to comply with local Japanese Government regulations which specify that no center fire rifle can have a barrel length of less than 19".

A sample Model 600 was sent to Nikko Industrial Company, our Distributors in Japan, and they have now advised us that they are interested in 100 units. They would like to know as soon as possible what the price would be, and when delivery could be made.

I would appreciate hearing from you at your earliest convenience on what it would cost us to have 100 Model 600's modified with this muzzle brake, and what delivery on 100 of these rifles we could expect.
