Howard Reinhard and I field tested the Model 660, 308 caliber rifle using the entire quantity of 40 rounds of ammunition sent from Bridgeport for this particular test.

In our opinion the rifle is satisfactory in every respect and there should be a good demand for it.

One suggestion would be to equip it with studs for sling strap swivels. Also, we found it difficult to align the gold-tinted front sight in the sunshine, although this probably would not be a deterrent in the woods.

The rifle is being returned to the attention of Victor DeReus at Ilion by REA Express.
