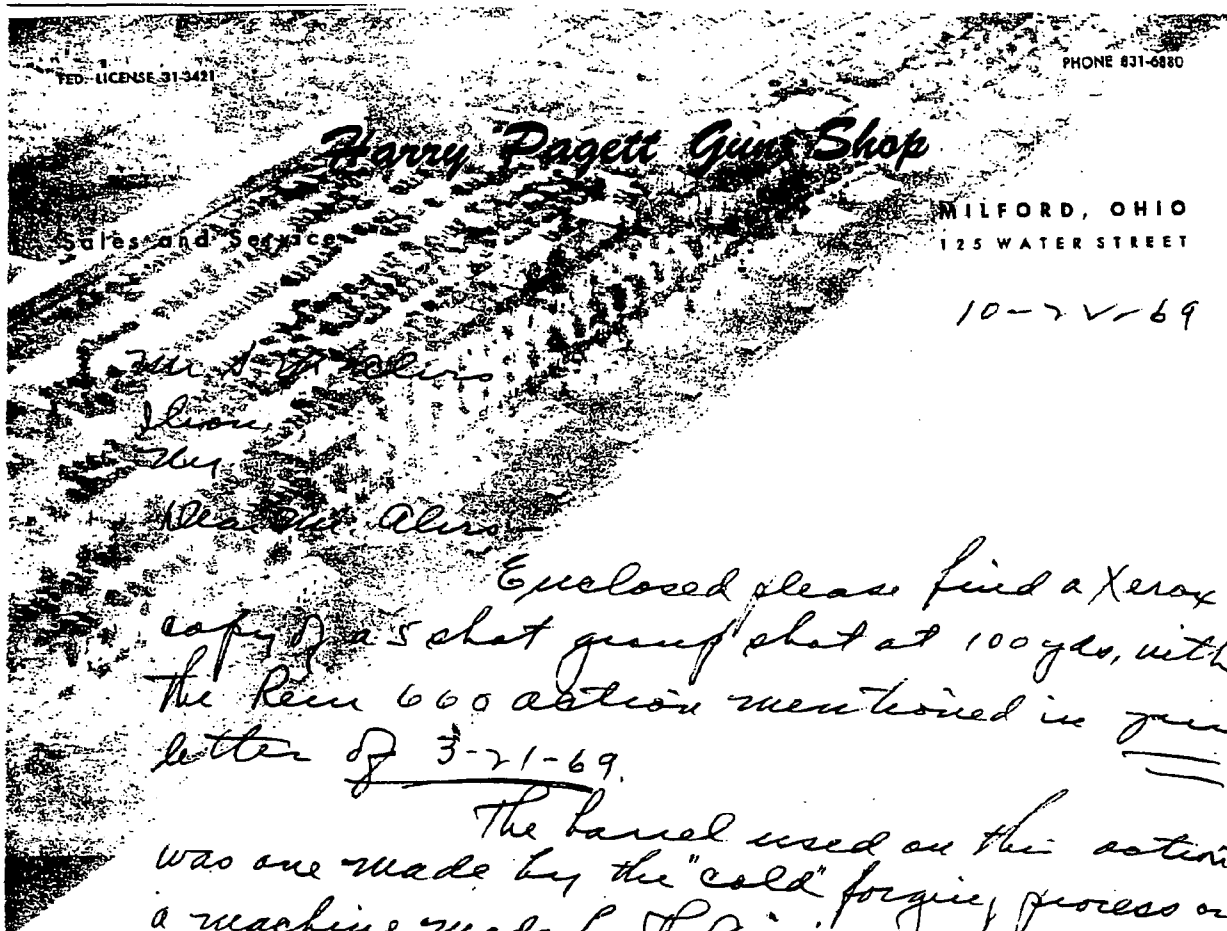




Enclosed please find a Xerox copy of a 5 shot pump shot at 100 yds, with the Rem 660 action mentioned in your letter of 3-21-69.

The barrel used on this action was one made by the "cold" forging process on a machine made by The Cincinnati Milling Machine Co. for General Motors.

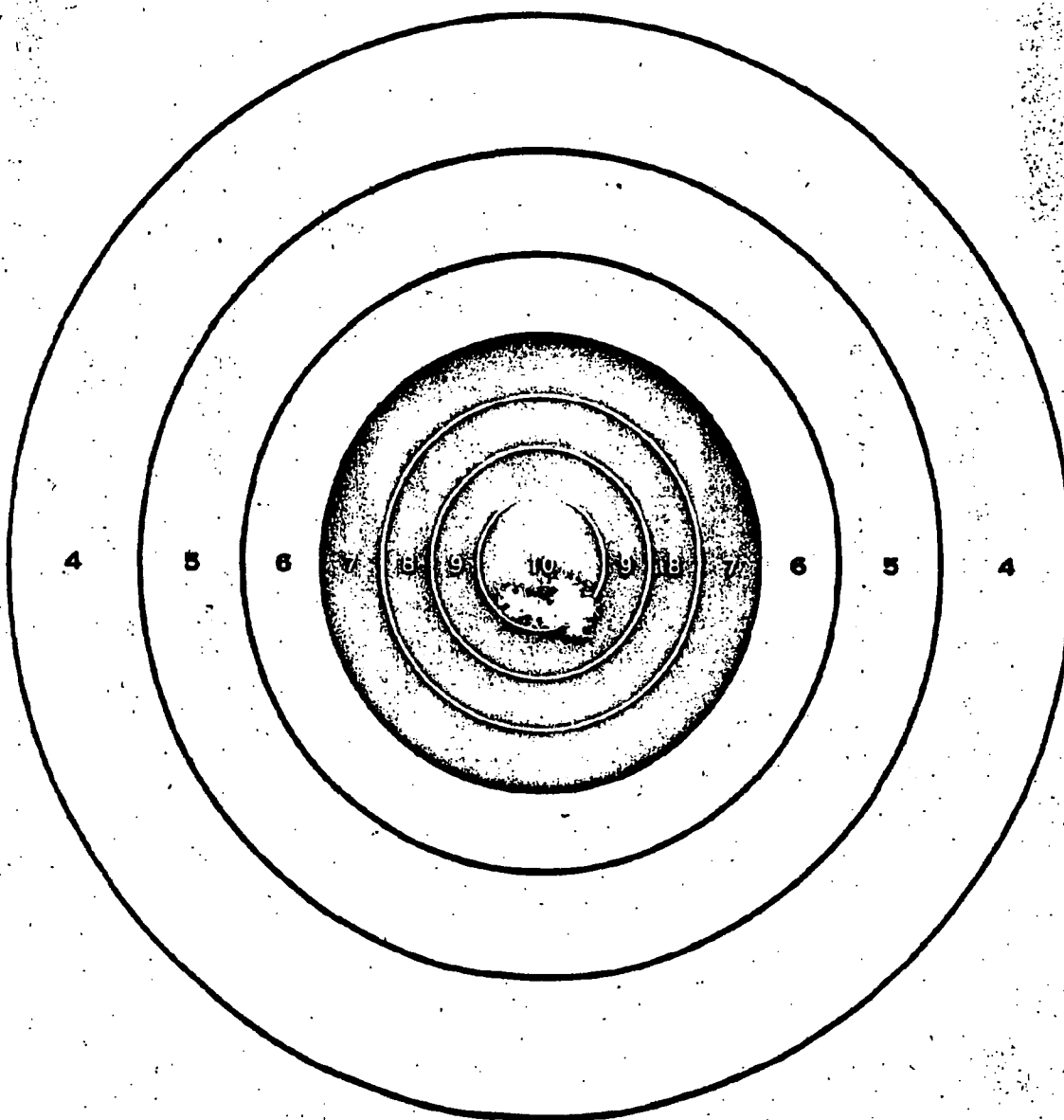
The technician who mounted the barrel and made the stock (South jaw) was a Mr "Slim" Nelson. He informs me you have a 20 power scope. If available please send brochure.
