	<u>Remington 660</u>	<u>Winchester 670</u>
operating smoothness:	good, magazine follower bears on bottom of bolt when operating with magazine empty, left receiver wall extends to center line of receiver toward front to minimize vertical bolt play	very good, no "anti-bind device" on this model, receiver-bolt interference can occur as with R700 ADL, magazine follower bears much less on bottom of bolt
bolt disassembly:	same as R700 ADL	with action closed and cocked, a small punch is inserted through hole in left side of bolt sleeve, this permits firing pin assembly to be unscrewed readily from bolt, further disassembly requires twisting spring stop collar 90°, tools required
bolt stroke, similar length cartridges:	3.84"	3.81" carbine
bolt body length:	4.88"	6.15"
bolt-bolt plug alignment toward rear of stroke:	same as R700 ADL	very similar to Remington system

All other bolt characteristics on both guns are similar to those of the higher priced models discussed earlier.
