In the last sentence of the above referred to letter dated December 18, 1969, we indicated that the above Sniper Rifles for the Marine Corps could be delivered at a rate of 100 per week.

After further study, it was found that this delivery rate was not feasible due to the very tight acceptance parameters as specified by the Marine Corps.
