## Receiver

The Vanguard receiver is of conventional Mauser design. The bolt locks into the receiver with two vertical, radially-opposed, lugs near the front of the bolt body.

Prior to the introduction of their Mark V action, Weatherby produced rifles on the F.N. commercial Mauser action. The Vanguard action is quite similar functionally to this older type.

Integral with receiver, houses front guard screw

Evidence suggests investment casting. All surfaces

are subsequently machined to some degree.

Surface Texture:

Very smooth on all visible external surfaces. The

polish is uniformly of high quality.

Excellent, very dark blue-black. The metal finish

is a definite appearance asset.

Drilled and Tapped:

Yes, the top of front and rear receiver bridges is tapped similar to the M/700. Neither side of the rear receiver bridge is tapped for receiver sight mounting.
