3/19/73 We have produced the 700 varminter in 308 caliber/RA 155 steel. It would require nothing new to produce this barrel since we presently carry it in our P/R. It would have to be produced on #4 GFM.

To produce the 40XB in 308 we would require development of GFM Form Templates and pre-GFM turn templates. If we didn't produce to a form, we could produce a straight blank which Gogol would have to machine down in his turn operation.

The Marines are currently talking about a 40XB in stainless which is more difficult to produce.
