### INTRODUCTION:

Per request of J. P. Linde an XP-100 pistol with an experimental Delrin Safety thumb piece and full shrouded bolt plug was subjected to the drop test described in S.A. A. M. I. letter dated August 7, 1974, Sec. 4.3, Page 6.

#### TEST OBJECTIVE:

Subject the XP-100 pistol with experimental safety thumb piece to drop test evaluation per S. A. A. M. I. letter dated August 7, 1974.

## TEST OBSERVATIONS:

- 1. The XP-100 SN 5142 firing pin assembly fell when subjected to the impact of the 3 lb. 12 oz. drop weight impacting on the bolt plug.
- 2. During the drop test the safe moved from safe-on to safe-off position.
- 3. No visible damage of the pistol was noted.
