INTRODUCTION:

An XP100 pistol with final design considerations of full shroud bolt plug and light weight safe thumb piece modifications was delivered to the measurement and test lab for drop test evaluation.

TEST OBJECTIVE:

Subject the XP100 to drop test evaluation per S.A.A.M.I. letter dated August 7, 1974.

TEST OBSERVATION:

1. The XP100 did not experience firing pin fall or safe position changes in the five drop test evaluation test.
2. No visible gun damage was noted in this test.
