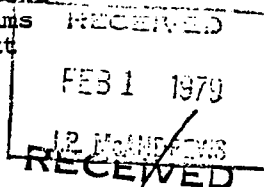

This customer contacted me this date in regards to my president's letter dated January 8, 1979 concerning a new Mohawk 600 rifle allegedly firing when pushing the safety off.

Mr. Pfennig gave me the name of the gunsmith he purchased the gun from and returned for reimbursement.

I called Mr. Ralph DeHart, Walnut Town, Pa. to have the gun returned to us for examination. He informed me that the gun was resold after he installed a new trigger assembly, at his expense.

The gunsmith is quite irate with Mr. Phennig and will not allow him in the store. After he refunded the money for the rifle, he disassembled it and found the trigger was tampered with and the housing was scratched and damaged. This rifle did not leave our factory or the gunsmith in this condition, as the gunsmith had it apart to install swivels and a recoil pad when purchased. At that time, the trigger assembly was not altered or marred in any way.

At my request, Mr. DeHart is going to ship the damaged trigger assembly to us for examination.
