

INTRODUCTION

The Technical Committee Manual Volume VII, Centerfire Rifle, issued by the Sporting Arms and Ammunition Manufacturers' Institute, Inc. represents the recommended limits of certain dimensions and performance criteria or characteristics related to safety and performance for newly manufactured firearms.

Manufacturers, gunsmiths, importers, and others interested in the safety and performance of firearms may adopt specifications within these limits. The gun owner is responsible for proper care and maintenance of his firearm.

Circulation is limited to SAAMI members and to certain U.S. Government agencies, because proper use of the Manual requires a technical background in this field and because of the difficulty of keeping the contents, which are subject to constant review and revision, up to date. Pertinent data sheets from this Manual will be made available to those who are in a position to utilize this information such as, gunsmiths and manufacturers, on payment of a reasonable charge. Available data needed in connection with government bids will be furnished on request.
