BARREL LENGTH

(Ballistic Measurement)

Centerfire Rifle barrels are measured by inserting a rod down the bore from the muzzle until it touches the breech face with the action closed and the firing-pin retracted.

Mark the point on the rod adjacent to the most forward part of the barrel or the bottom of the counterbore in guns having a counterbore recess at the muzzle. The rod is then removed and the distance from the mark to the end of the rod is measured with a scale or rule. This is the barrel length.

(Legal Measurement)

Centerfire Rifle barrels are measured by inserting a rod down the bore from the muzzle until it touches the breech face with the action closed and the firing-pin retracted.

Mark the point on the rod adjacent to the most forward part of the barrel. The rod is then removed, and the distance from the mark to the end of the rod is measured with a scale or rule. This is the barrel length.
