M-700 7MM EXP. REM.

A meeting was held March 29 to discuss the targeting problems encountered with the Model 700 7MM EXP. REM. Attending were:

As the result of R & D testing on the re-worked 7MM EXP. REM. guns, a hold was put on the warehouse. It was found that while they could be passed using 150 grain ammunition, they would not target when 165 grain ammunition was used. It was decided that:

- . All 900 guns marked 7MM EXP. REM. in the warehouse would be pulled and retargeted using 165 grain ammunition.
- . Any gun which passed the re-targeting could be repacked and returned to the warehouse.
- . A sample of those guns which failed to target would be made available to R & D for investigation into the cause.
- . Retargeting will begin immediately.

Work order number 86215 has been assigned to cover the cost of this retest.
