MODEL 600 RECALL STATUS

Attached per your request is Red Sherman's recent report on our recall status. Please note the following pertinent statistics:

- Total repairs to date approximate 21,000 units.
- Our estimate of the total to be repaired is 23,000 units which is 12% of the 191,424 guns sold subject to recall.
- Total inventory of fire controls approximates 3000 which is adequate to cover our projected needs. Red Sherman is contacting the gun repair stations to develop a plan for effective utilization of this inventory.


In reference to our conversation on the FFL mailings, I checked with Al Bell who said our total mailing amounted to approximately 140M and was completed on 9/7/79.
