XP 100 S I G H T S

Research has shot the new XP-100 pistol in 7mm BR Caliber at 100 yards using the sights available on the market that can be fastened directly to the action as received. The following are our findings.

<u>Receiver Sight</u>	<u>Front Sight</u>
Lyman 57 WJS	Lyman 17 AHB
Williams 600 TK-BL	Lyman 17 AM 1

The new BO-MAR sight will work with the Lyman 17 AUG with proper sight radius. The Redfield globe front sights were not available but are similar to the Lyman front sight. The Redfield No. 68 globe sight is listed as having the same height as the Lyman 7AM1 sight and therefore could be used with the Williams 600 TK-BL rear sight.

The Redfield "Palma" rear sight was not available.
