Dear Allan:

Thanks for your letter of April 7th. I have reviewed the trigger assembly with our Mr. Paul Tubbs, Technical Manager. Since no specific lubrication problems have been mentioned by Remington, we assume there are none. We recommend consideration of our Penetrating Oil #1. This product has been in our line for almost 50 years and has been used for a variety of tasks. The use of the product for cleaning trigger mechanisms has been confirmed by one of our distributor men who has used it for many years. He does not practice lubrication of trigger assemblies only cleaning. Where lubrication is desired we recommend our Penetrating Oil #2.

I am sending you samples of both products. The trigger assembly is enclosed.

Allan, it would be helpful to us if you could provide a list of Keystone products which have been accepted by DuPont. During our presentation at Louviers I was informed that our KSL compressor and gear lubricants have been placed on your list.
