SUBJECT: M/40XR SILHOUETTE RIFLE

A proto-type rifle has been assembled from standard parts to meet the rules of rim-fire metallic silhouette shooting. The parts used were:

- M/40XR barreled action complete
- <sup>ADD</sup> M/700, short action stock altered to:
  - Accept a heavy barreled action
  - Eliminate magazine inletting, grip cap, and fore-end tip

The rifle was assembled using standard tools. Eleven more samples will be assembled when barreled actions become available. This will be approximately September 15.
