Gentlemen:

In your January, 1973, magazine you had an article entitled, "Caution Notice on Spray Lubricants." This article told about a Seattle police officer who was assaulted and his weapon subsequently malfunctioned. The officer's department lab found the primers inerted by the use of spray oil.

Upon reading this article, the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department tested the duty ammunition presently in service, and the proposed duty ammunition to be issued September, 1973.

In these tests, we found a spray lubricant that is an excellent demoisurant, with excellent characteristics as a penetrant. We further found one of the brands of ammunition to have an excellent primer seal.

Due to the seriousness of the effects to ammunition that are caused by misuse of spray lubricants, I have enclosed a copy of our tests and a copy of the article mentioned above, which we issued to our officers.

This department is presently issuing the Smith & Wesson Model 39 9mm Semi-automatic Pistol.
