The present sight is made from a powder metal leaded brass. I understand the plant must stop using the leaded brass.

We have tested powder metal iron samples and they are as good or better than other parts we make from the same material. The parts must be Loctite impregnated before color and a white dot painted on after color. Marked prints are attached.

We would like to have costs prepared and present the change to the Operations Committee.
