Surprise! Surprise! We have finally received the Stanton O. Berg firearms analysis. It is interesting to note that it was accomplished September 5, 1982 and they are only now getting around to furnishing it to us. Having reviewed the report I can understand their significant delay in furnishing it to us. You will note that he was not able to make the gun misfire.

The inability to make the gun misfire, and therefore the unavailability of an expert witness against Remington, raises, of course, the question as to what we are doing in this lawsuit. I will be in contact with Attorneys Day and Bliss to see if with this report in hand we might now simply terminate our involvement, rather than proceeding with the necessity of further workup and investigation. We'll keep you advised.

I do assume, Greg, that you will be furnishing this to Remington Arms and soliciting their views. I will look forward to hearing from any word from Remington in this regard. We will keep you advised.
