MODEL 700 MOUNTAIN RIFLE:

Special, lightweight version of the Remington Model 700 bolt action centerfire rifle. 6-3/4 lbs. weight. Easier carrying while retaining proven, big game, long range performance. Stock favorite design of custom stockmakers -- straight-line comb with cheek piece. Satin stock finish. 22-inch barrel. Fine checkering. Returns legendary 280 Remington cartridge to bolt action, big game rifle. Also in 270 Win. & 30-06.

NEW "REM" CHOKE INTERCHANGEABLE CHOKE TUBES:

Remington introduces its new interchangeable choke tube system for wide range of 12-gauge M 1100 autoloading & M 870 pump action shotguns. Three field chokes -- improved cylinder, modified and full. Exceptionally strong. Will handle heaviest lead magnum loads as well as all steel shot loads. Available in most 12-gauge Remington Model 1100 and 870 field guns, SP Magnums, Special Field and "Sportsman" 12 Autos and Pumps.

NEW STYLE FOR MODEL 870 12-GAUGE "WINGMASTER":

Completely restyled Model 870 "Wingmaster" 12-gauge shotguns. Generous amount of raised-diamond, cut checkering. Low gloss, satin wood finish. Standard 3-inch chambers for all lead and steel 12-gauge shells. With new "Rem" Choke in 26 & 28-inch barrels.

NON-REFLECTIVE FINISH ON M 1100 AND M 870 DEER GUNS:

Both Model 1100 and 870 Deer Guns to now have Parkerized finish on all exposed metal surfaces and dull, non-reflective oil finish on stocks. Similar to 1985's Model 1100 and 870 SP Magnums. With Q.D. sling swivels and wide, camou carrying sling. Chrome-lined barrels. Adjustable iron sights with white, ivory bead as front sight. Improved cylinder chokes for optimum slug accuracy.

XP-100 VARMINT SPECIAL IN 223 REMINGTON:

Remington's XP-100 Bolt Action, Single Shot pistol with 14-1/2 inch "Silhouette" style barrel chambered for popular long-range varmint round, the 223 Remington. Receiver drilled and tapped for handgun scope mounts. The XP-100 "Varmint Special" with its rifle-type accuracy opens new opportunities for the growing sport of long-range, handgun hunting for small game.

REMINGTON RETURNS MODEL 581 RIM FIRE RIFLE:

In answer to shooter demand, Remington returns popular Model 581 bolt action, clip fed rimfire rifle as part of "Sportsman" series. Same original rifle with reputation for accuracy for small game hunting and Junior target competition. Features Remington's unique and exceptionally strong rear lockup system, centerfire trigger mechanism, oversized trigger guard and fastest lock time of any known rifle.

"Sportsman" 78 is "no frills" version of famous Model 700 bolt action, centerfire rifle. Standard Model 700 barreled action in plain, uncheckered stock provides shooter economy without loss of well-known Model 700 "out-of-the-box" accuracy. For long range, small game hunters, now chambered for accurate 223 Remington cartridge.

MODEL 700 CLASSIC IN LIMITED RUN OF 264 WIN. MAGNUM:

Remington's much anticipated annual limited production of the Model 700 Classic bolt action centerfire rifle for selected cartridge -- in 1986, the 264 Win. Magnum. Traditional, "Rifleman's" straight comb classic stock with its clean, attractive lines. 24-inch barrel for maximum velocity. Sixth in a series of annual limited production 700 Classic rifles that are rapidly achieving "Collector" status.

Available in Custom Shop Grades I through IV with selection of all special options of Model 700 Custom rifles. In 22-250 Rem., 243 Win., 6mm Rem., 6.5mm Rem. Magnum, 7mm-08 Rem., 308 Win., 350 Rem. Magnum and others.

RETURN OF 8MM REM. MAGNUM IN MODEL 700 SAFARI GRADE:

Another example of Remington listening to what even select groups of hunters want -- the return of the high performance 8mm Rem. Magnum big game cartridge in the Safari-Grade series. Will be available in two options: Model 700 Monte Carlo Safari with contemporary Monte Carlo comb and cheek piece, heavy, varmint-weight barrel, iron sights, rosewood fore-end tip and pistol grip cap; Model 700 Safari Classic with classic-style stock, clean, Magnum-weight barrel with iron sights as option. Also new availability of Model 700 Safari Classic with heavy, varmint-weight barrel in 458 Win. Magnum. All Safari grade rifles available on special order from Remington Custom Shop through select Remington dealers.
