① Stock Styles - all too short for B.A.R.

S - recoil pad, small fore-grip, good pistol grip, shouldered well
to short for today's male

R - quality, more cuts (sculptured)

Q - feel, biggest grip, good grip, flat bottom foreend

Least T - small grip, looks rifle

check piece needed for scoped rifles

all use scopes

② Receiver Styles

Q rd. w/ mounts

See over Rd.

S - integral mounts more reliable. (from one who has both)
looks stronger, cost advantage

T - prefer plain round, cleaner round

③ Barrel Styles

Best 5 - hammered, tapered, looks good, new more massive hb) has less kick

Q - heavier hb, slim barrel heats up, walks

1 - lightest, easiest to carry
 least Q - too short, heavy

5 - glove is problem

as cosmetic feature → not interested	both grabs bite.
as functional imp → interested!	

"if they could taper down a hb and make it light I'd buy it." (again functional)

④ Magazines

Best floorplate 1 - Sleeker

detachable 7 - carry 2, more convenient, quicker
 easier with gloves, faster

Least

floorplate "loading must work at thru chamber to unload"

floorplate - loose shells rattle, deform

detachable - bulges, but is functional, ok



⑤ BOLT LOCK

- a) 5 1-1 age for youth, does not deter
- 2 2-1 (locking button is redundant, bolt that unlocks is on fire like old BDL)
- 1 3-1 habit but different story for kids

purpose is safety feature

snags in brush is an imp. need for bolt lock

b) location

M - side finger - easier reached w/ thumb (6 count)
 gives present a problem w/ this design

R - bolt peg, easier to operate

likes bolt lock but not extra mechanism



⑥ Bolt Release

S - Side tang - easier, can snag gets in way accidents
more control of rifle

Q - easier, natural grip, problem w/ gloves
hidden out of the way (good)
deliberate motion req'd to close to trigger

⑦ Bolt Plug exposed/non

a) enclosed ~~exposed~~ - keeps it clean

exposed - visual check, oiled but gets dirty, freeze up
easier to oil

b) S - slender scalloped least

R - short, thick, best

M - Ad rand

cosmetic only



② Bolt knob - all must clear scope

T & M knurled & all like knurled (7 vs 1)

S - least ~~exposed~~ slippery gives ~~problem~~
small

M - large

Q & R - round no details, likes better, no care for knurled sort.

③ Safety location

R - side tang wins 6 vs 2.

S - tang safety too far rear, unnatural, &

quietness important
