Enclosed are two sets of the NBAR Magazine Box prints which we agreed that I'd send you. Please note the following on the Magazine Box (D-exp-1758A), the Floor Plate (C-exp-1901) and the Magazine Box Assembly (C-exp-1902) :

- * The tabs at the bottom of the box are bent inside rather than outside as previously discussed. This will allow us to have only one mat'l. thickness protruding below the trigger guard.
- * The width of these bottom tabs T.B.D. by you. Also, if you prefer several small tabs rather than one long tab, fine (so long as the Mag. Box Assembly specs. can be held).
- * Position and size of gauging hole T.B.D. by you.
- * The magazine's feed lips cannot be parallel to the sides of the box as I had hoped. They would not contain the cartridges.

- * The Magazine Box print does not show the fastening. This should be as we discussed on April 21 (at the rear in a similar fashion as the model 788 box with H&P to determine the positioning and size of the interlocking tabs and their

- * Included is the fold-over latch at the front of the box. You may need to notch out some bend relief at the corners in order to fold this over.
