SUBJECT: FEBRUARY MONTHLY REPORT

The major thrust in February continues to be the evaluation of O/U components. As production prototypes are made, the metallurgical processing, process record standards and performance characteristics are measured. Improvements to the O/U Product have been significant and have required extensive revisions to the metallurgical processing.

A major focus on the O/U is to identify a local radiograph test laboratory and reduce turn around on barrel assembly inspections. We have qualified Trutom Limited in Latham, N.Y. with a 3-day turn around on a routine basis.

Other significant activities include:

- Cramer v. Remington case preparation;
- N-BAR bullet analysis;
- Barnes X bullet analysis and prototypes;
- Cole v. Remington case review; and
- Assistance to ATO on metallurgy.
