Metallurgy support this month was very heavily focused at arms service, firearm gun examinations and discovery requirements for representation of Remington in pending litigation.

Specific items, other than pre-litigation, where progress has been made relate to plant assistance and product service:

Plant Assistance

Lot sampling for x-ray analysis of O/U brazed barrel assemblies was instituted May 12th. This will save over \$10,000/month at projected production schedules.

ERW (Electrical Resistance Weld) audit of O/U vent ribs.

MIM Shotqun choke tube wrench process audit to improve flow and yields.
